Henry joined GGA in 2008 after nine years as the Vice President – Golf of Pulte Homes, the largest developer of golf course communities in the U.S. While at Pulte Homes, Henry developed 27 golf courses in 10 states. During

his tenure, Pulte Homes became the largest developer of golf communities and of golf courses in the U.S. with more than \$500 million in developed golf assets. In addition, he was responsible for the operation of more than 20 Pulte golf courses.

Henry is a "go to" resource on matters of golf-related resort and residential investment and development, Henry is often asked by U.S. and international media to comment on social and economic trends affecting the golf business. He was educated at Oklahoma State University where he was an All-American golfer.
